

This popular wheel has the double drive tension system for fine worsted yarns and the scotch tension option for spinning softer woollen yarns.

This versatile wheel will spin fine yarns with the high drive ratio and softer woollen yarns with the low drive ratio. One adjustment controls both drive band and bobbin take-up. Horizontal adjustment of the maiden bar allows perfect alignment with the 2 speed whorl.

Ball bearings and large 56cm (22ins) wheel makes treadling smooth and effortless and easy to maintain a steady speed. The wide legs give good stability especially when speed spinning. The treadle is pivoted to allow a comfortable heel-toe action. Lazy Kate and 4 bobbins included. The many optional accessories make this an extremely versatile wheel.

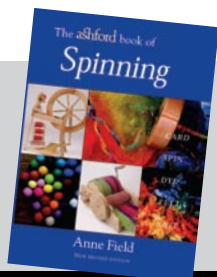

- Jumbo Double Drive Sliding Hook Flyer and Bobbin – fill jumbo bobbins evenly
- High Speed Double Drive Adapter Kit – for fine spinning with higher ratios
- Traditional Double Treadle Kit – replace one treadle with two
- Competition Lazy Kate – for bobbin control when plying at speed
- Distaff – attachment to aid linen flax spinning
- Quill spindle – spin from a point and wind bobbins

- Spinning Chair – for comfortable spinning
- Niddy Noddy – wind yarn directly from the bobbin into 1.5m (5 ft) skeins
- Sampler Niddy Noddy – make small, sample 90cm (1yd) skeins
- Maintenance Kit – spare parts and lubricating oil
- Ashford Teak Wax - protect and restore the wood
- Yarn Gauge – ascertain the yarn gauge

Maintenance

Apply Ashford spinning wheel oil to moving parts as shown in the assembly guides, every two to three hours of spinning. Wax your wheel regularly with Ashford Teak Wax, furniture oil or polish.
