



Ashford Tekapo Gauntlets

With the cooler weather now upon us, the Craftshop girls have designed a stylish, practical pair of gauntlets, knitted in a 2/1 rib for a snug fit on the hand.

This is an easy beginner knitter pattern.

You will need:

- 1 100gram ball of Ashford Tekapo yarn
- 1 pair 4mm needles

Here's how:

Cast on 51 sts

Pattern

Row 1: Knit 2 purl 1* repeat to end of row.

Row 2: Knit 1 purl 2* repeat to end of row.

Work these two rows until knitting measures 15cm or desired length.

Finishing on 2nd row.

Cast off for thumb slit

*Pattern 4 across stitches, cast off 5 sts, pattern to end.

Next row: Pattern across 42 stitches, cast on 5 stitches, pattern to end of row. (51 sts).

Work another 6cm, or desired length.

Cast off.

Finishing

Sew seam using back stitch.

For second gauntlet. Cast off for thumb slit,

Pattern 42 stitches, cast off 5 stitches, pattern to end of row.

Next row: Pattern 4 stitches, cast on 5 stitches, work to end of row. (51 sts).
