



Child's Opal Tank Top

You will need:

100gms of Opal wool (Memory colours below)
1 pair 3.25 needles

Size:

56-61cm (22-24ins) 2 – 4 years

To start the year we have designed a quick summer knit for you - a child's tank top in self-patterning Opal sock yarn from Germany. The top takes just one 100gram ball of Opal yarn and has optional button details on shoulder straps and sides of top. This top is machine-washable - a huge bonus for busy mums!



Back & Front - the same

Cast on 78 stitches

K2, P2 rib for 6cm (optional 2 buttonholes each side on back)

Continue in Stocking Stitch until work measures 20cm or length required.

Shape Armhole

Cast off 5 st beginning of next 2 rows

Dec 1 each end next and following alt rows until 60 st remain

Continue straight until armhole measures 8cm.

Neck

Knit 20 st Cast off 20 st Knit 20 st

Continue on last 20 st k2tog at neck edge for 2 rows (18st)

Cont until armhole measures 11cm, cast off.

Rejoin wool at neck edge of other side k2tog at neck edge next 2 rows (18st)
Cont until 11cm and cast off.

Make Up

Join side seams and shoulder seams.

(Optional: Crochet around neck and armholes)
2 buttons at each side & shoulders if required.
