


TENSIONED LAZY KATE

For single and double drive, standard and jumbo bobbins



No more bobbins over-winding when plying at speed! Control your bobbins when plying with the adjustable brake tension. Convenient carry handle.

Assembly

- 1. Attach the four rubber feet to the base of the lazy kate with the small screws.
- 2. Thread the screw eye (with the tension spring attached) into the hole.
- 3. Place the steel rods in the three holes.
- 4. Squeeze the metal yarn guide and insert into holes.
- 5. Tie one end of the nylon brake band to the tension spring and thread the other end through the hole in the wooden tension knob and tie a knot. Insert the tension knob into the hole.

Your Tensioned Lazy Kate is ready to use.

Here's how

- 1. Place bobbins onto the rods.
- 2. Place the nylon brake band in the bottom groove in the bobbin ends.
- 3. Adjust the tension of the brake band by twisting the tension knob.
- 4. Take the yarn from each bobbin (two or three), thread through the metal yarn guide and attach to an empty bobbin on your spinning wheel.
- You can ply with the Tensioned Lazy Kate on the floor or on a table beside you.
